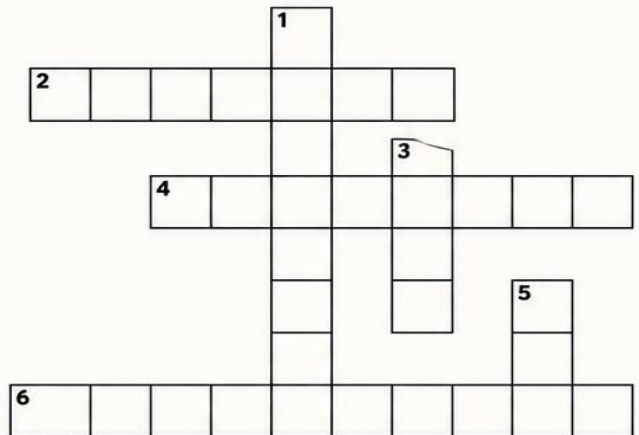

The Vault Opens in Milton

Milton is excited to welcome **The Vault** to our city! It is a great place to enjoy excellent food, watch your favorite sports, grab a delicious burger or an awesome pizza, and spend time with friends. Whether you are looking for an ice-cold drink or a great meal, **The Vault** will not let you down.

City Updates

Project 1: Hillview Water Line Replacement

The City replaced approximately **600 feet** of **2-inch galvanized water line** with **2-inch PVC pipe** on Hillview, extending to Wendy's. This project improves water quality and provides more reliable, modern infrastructure for the area.

Project 2: Woodline Drive Water Main Upgrade

The City is replacing the existing **4-inch water main** with a **6-inch C900 PVC water main** on Woodline Drive. The project also includes the installation of a new fire hydrant on Woodline Drive and another new hydrant on Trenol Road. Approximately **950 feet** of water line will be replaced, and the project is expected to be completed in about **one month**.

Project 3: Woodland Court Water Line Installation

The City installed **80 feet** of new **2-inch water line** on Woodland Court to improve service and support future infrastructure needs.

Safety Tip: Beat the Heat

Stay hydrated and take frequent breaks when working outdoors. During periods of excessive heat, limit strenuous outdoor activities to the early morning or evening hours whenever possible.
